Before the Alberta Minimum Wage Act was passed many of you were getting a wage of not more than nine dollars per week, with little hope of getting more.

The Minimum Wage Act brought your wages up to \$12.50, and in some cases \$14.00. Seventy-five per cent. of the women workers of the Province had their wages raised by the Minimum Wage Act. The operation of the Act has meant an increase of \$150,000 in the wages of the working women of the Province.

The Labour Party secured the Minimum Wage Act for you. It was done when Labour only had four members in the Legislature.

LESSONS FROM THE BRITISH STRIKE

The British Industrial Crisis is full of lessons not only to the British, but to Canadian workers also.

It is full of lessons to the Workers in Edmonton.

The British miners refuse to be reduced to the level of **Coolies**, while operators make millions of pounds in profits.

The whole British Trade union movement realized that a cut to the miners or longer hours, was, in the final analysis, a challenge to the standard of the whole working class.

THEY WERE FORCED TO DECLARE A GENERAL STRIKE

The Conservative Government of Great Britain invoked the Emergency Powers Act, thereby mobilizing all the forces of the State, Army, Navy, etc., to war dimensions.

The Conservative Party—the party of the **Bosses** in all countries, voted into power by millions of workers and their wives, proves that it will, if need be, force the workers to work for **Coolie wages**, in order that the Coal Barons and other Barons may make profits.

Such a lesson for the Workers and their wives, who voted for Baldwin and the Conservative Party—and to you fellow worker! What a lesson!! On top of the lessons you should have learned of the action of a Liberal Party in Power in Canada.

When troops were sent to Nova Scotia, to force the miners to starve in order that the **British Empire Steel Corporation could pay interest on its WATERED STOCK**—and the lesson of a Conservative Government in power during the strike of 1919 in Winnipeg.
