Beck to Charles Pinker, M. McCauley and E.J. Bangs, October 20, 1894	1894-1898, 1901, 1902	
2	1	5	Ledger - Day book - daily accounts ledger of M. McCauley business (no name), of meat (beef, pork, fish, lamb, mutton), water, stables and hauling. October 1887 to October 1890. - includes names such as Hardisty, Humberstone, McDougall, Walters, Taylor, Rowland, Father Grandin, Ross Brothers, Lauder, Rev. McQueen, etc., - nb: entries of meat taper off by November 1889 and remaining entries are for livery and hauling	1887-1890	
3	1	6	Ledger - Day book- daily accounts ledger of M. McCauley's butcher shop (no name), October 1, 1890 to June 13, 1891. - includes names such as Fraser, McDougall, Sanderson, Hardisty, N.W.M. Police - selling steak, beef, pork, fish, sausage, bacon, mutton, lard, suet, boil (potatoes?),	1890-1891	
3	1	7	Ledger - Day book - daily accounts ledger of M. McCauley business (no name), stable, feed (hay, oats), renting equipment (ex. cutters, rigs, buggies) and hauling. November 1, 1891 to December 25, 1892. - includes names such as Hardisty, Taylor, Ottewell, McNab, etc., - many strangers make use of stables in April & May, - buckboard, horse & rig are popular; change to horse & cutter in winter; horse & bobsleigh (December 26, 1891); - May 2, 1892, passengers from train \$1.00, - 1892, 1 load of hay \$6.00 - entries in the ledger are written in many different handwritings	1891-1892	

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4	1	8	Ledger - Day book - daily accounts ledger of Matthew McCauley Livery, Feed and Sale Stables. December 28, 1892 to May 6, 1894. - includes names such as Taylor, Lauder, Hardisty, Bellerose, Ross, Braithwaite, McLeod, Dr. True, etc., - horse & rig \$1.00, - stabling horse or team \$0.25 per night; stabling horse teams becomes more frequent; half of rentals was for horse & cutters, - farm equipment for rent (combined plough \$25.00, John Deere brush plow \$28.00 - December 1893 saw a great demand for oats, - entries in the ledger are written in many different handwritings	1892-1894	
5	1	9	Ledger - Day book - daily accounts ledger of M. McCauley business (no name). May 6, 1894 to December 7, 1895. - includes names such as Humberstone, Lauder, Secord, Taylor, Duggan, etc., - majority of entries are stabling horse or stabling team, - entries in the ledger are written in many different handwritings	1894-1895	
6	1	10	Daily accounts ledger of Matthew McCauley Livery, Feed and Sale Stables, March 12, 1897 to December 12, 1898. - includes names such as Sutherland, Kelly, Ross, Taylor, Groat, Ottewell, etc., - occasional entries of sell a horse and 'service a mare', - numbers on left of entries are account numbers (see general accounts ledger f. 16) - entries in the ledger are written in many different handwritings	1897-1898	
7	1	11	Day book - daily accounts ledger M. McCauley - Edmonton Cartage Co., December 1898 to January 1900. - includes names such as Humberstone, Groat, Bellerose, Gregoire, Duggan, etc., - majority of entries are for stabling horse or stabling team	1898-1900	
8	1	12	General accounts ledger for the Livery Stables, Grain, Hay, Horses and Farm Implements, 1897 to 1899. - general accounts corresponding to daily transactions ledger, f. 14	1897-1899	
9	1	13	Ledger - Day book - daily accounts ledger for Matthew McCauley Freight (Cartage Company), June 30, 1896 to May 11, 1899; two entries at end for December 18, 1897 and December 15, 1898. - includes names such as McDougall, Ross Bros., Secord, Hudson's Bay Co., Richardson, Edmonton Electric Light Co., Garipey & Co., - most entries indicate hauling or freight., - numbers on left of entries is account number (see general accounts ledger f. 19)	1896-1899	
10	1	14	Ledger - Day book - daily accounts ledger for Matthew McCauley Freight (Cartage Company), May 13, 1899 to September 29, 1900. - includes names such as Edmonton Milling Co., Blowey, Ross Bros., Taylor, McDougall, Edmonton Telephone Co., Beck, Treaty Commissioners, Massey Harris Co., Hudson's Bay Co., - most entries indicate hauling freight or baggage, - numbers on left of entries are account numbers (see general accounts ledger f. 19)	1899-1900	
11	1	15	Ledger - General accounts ledger for Matthew McCauley Freight (Cartage Company), July 1896 to April 1901. - accounts correspond to daily transactions ledger, f. 17 & f. 18, - interesting to note - the account for the Hudson's Bay Co., July 1896 to Sept 1897 is 10 pages of entries	1896-1901	
12	1	16	Ledger - Individual account ledger for Matthew McCauley Cartage Company, 1901 to 1902. - includes alphabetical index, - likely the General Accounts ledger but this fonds does not have the corresponding ledgers of daily transactions for this time period	1901-1902
